

A Service for Baby Dedication

Baptists believe that christening or baptism of an infant is wrong due to the fact that baptism took place in the New Testament only for those who had consciously chosen to follow Christ and had been converted. There is a need today, however, for a time of dedication of newborn babies and their parents to the Lord. This dedication would provide a constant reminder to the congregation of our commitment to children. It would also be a reminder to all parents of their biblical responsibility to raise their children in the admonition of the Lord. The timing of this rite could occur either at the birth of the child or on a specific calendar date such as given for sanctity of life Sunday. Here is a suggested order of worship for this sacred action.

Service for Celebration and Dedication of Life

Worship in Praise

Organ Prelude “How Firm a Foundation”
(arr. Hermon Voss)

Call to Worship “Savior, Teach Me Day by Day” (Strattner)
Presented by the Children’s Choir

Hymn of Praise #555 “I’m a Child of the King” (Sumner)

Worship in the Dedication of Life

Responsive Reading #670 (based on Ps. 139)

Hymn of Dedication #592 “Jesus Loves the Little Children” (Root)
**(Parents with babies enter on last stanza of hymn.)*

Pastoral introduction of Parents and Babies
**(A white New Testament with child’s name engraved on it is given to each family.)*

Vows of Parental Commitment
**(The vows are read aloud by leader, parents, and congregation.)*

Worship in Prayer

Pasoral Prayer of Dedication
**(This prayer would dedicate the infants to the Lord, ask for wisdom and guidance for parents, and commit to God as a church to do everything possible to lead these children to Him.)*

Worship in Commitment
