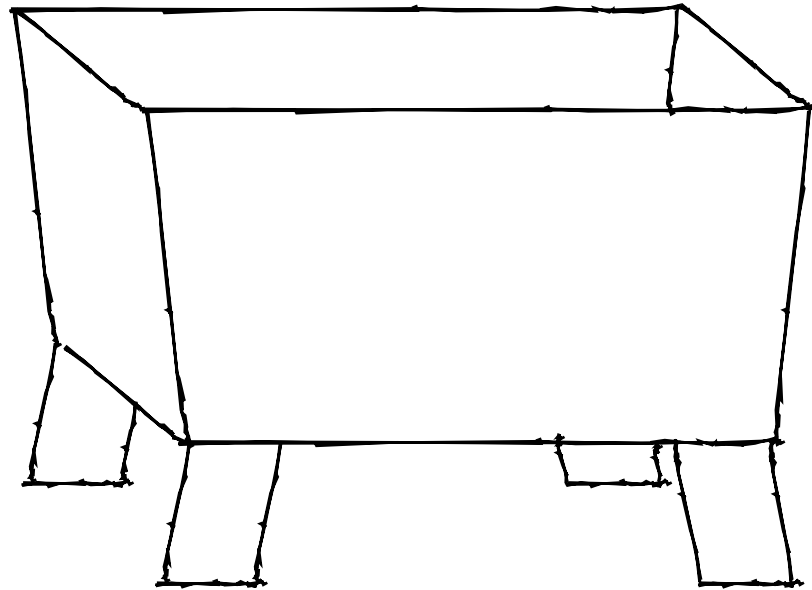


The Story of Jesus

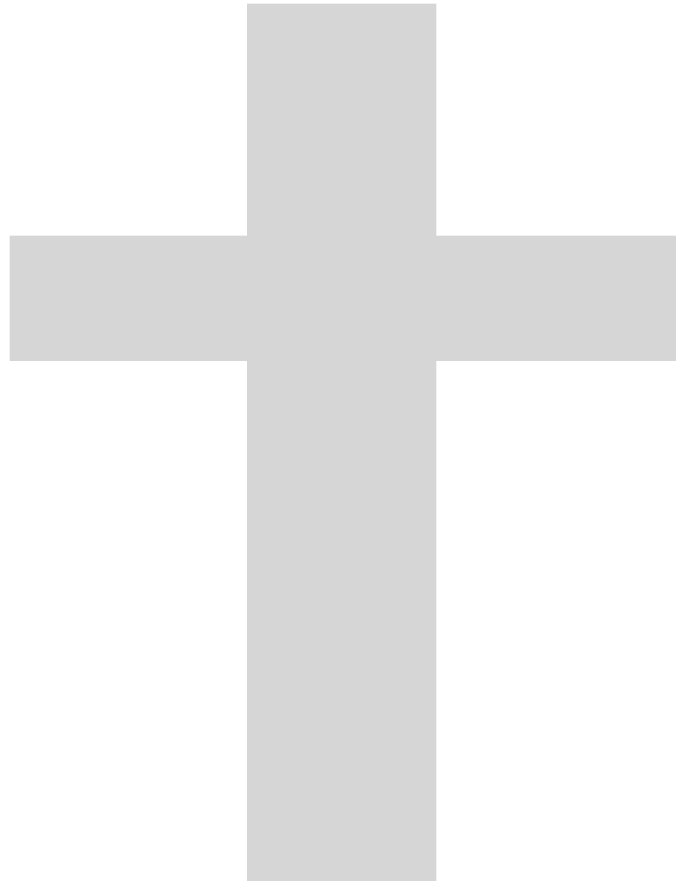
Jesus taught of God's love and performed miracles too. Inside the purple egg is a reminder for you.

Draw 5 loaves of bread and 2 fish.

How many people were fed with this food? \_\_\_\_\_

17 "We have here only five loaves of bread and two fish," they answered. 18 "Bring them here to me," he said. 19 And he directed the people to sit down on the grass. Taking the five loaves and the two fish and looking up to heaven, he gave thanks and broke the loaves. Then he gave them to the disciples, and the disciples gave them to the people. 20 They all ate and were satisfied, and the disciples picked up twelve basketfuls of broken pieces that were left over. 21 The number of those who ate was about five thousand men, besides women and children. Matthew 14:17-21 (NIV)

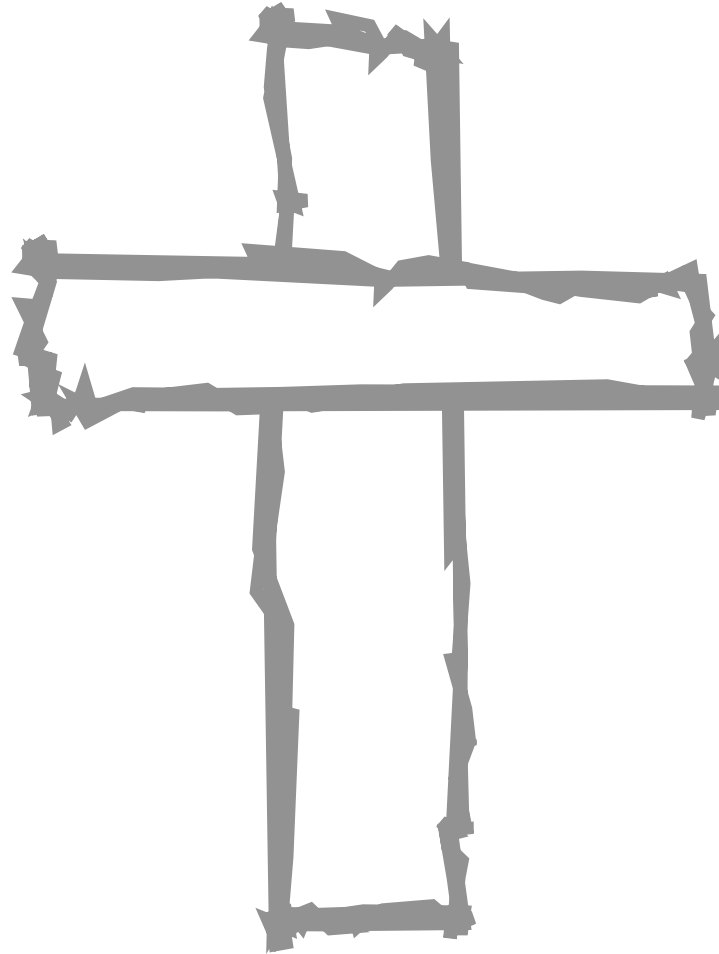
Open the red egg and wear what's inside.

16 For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16 (NIV)

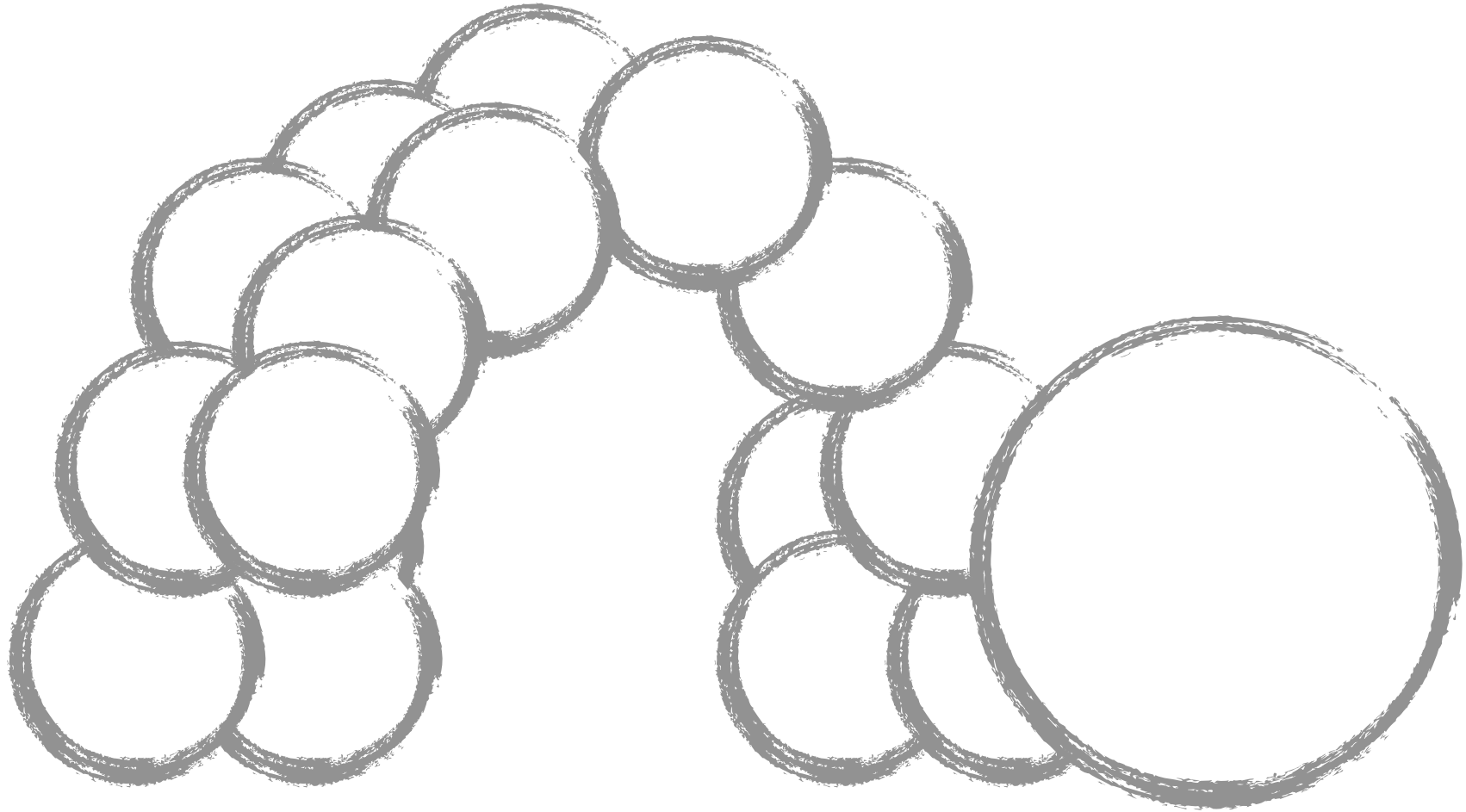
Open the white egg and use what's inside.

1 John 1:9 (NIV)

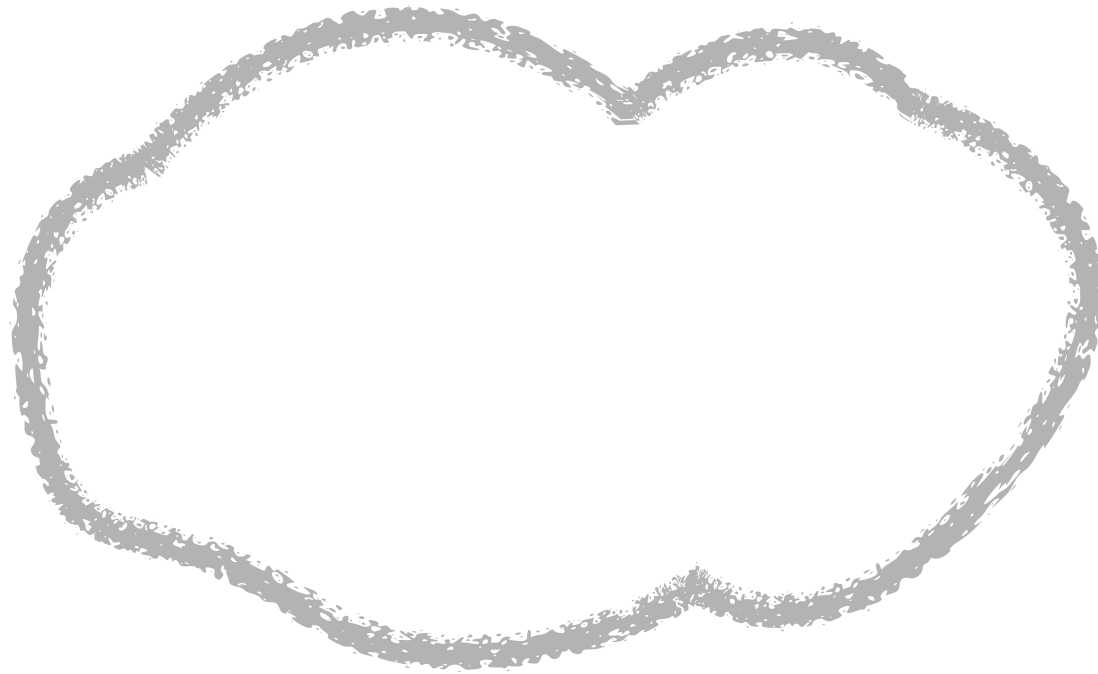
The pink egg is empty - there's nothing inside.  
Jesus came back to life after he died.



Draw Jesus outside of the empty tomb.

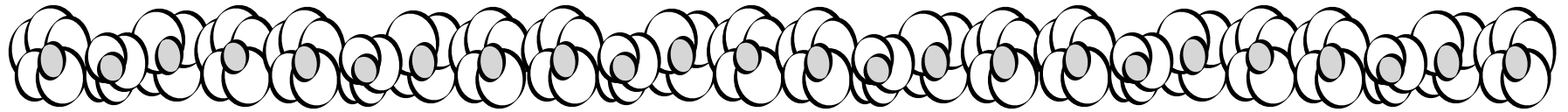
5 The angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. 6 He is not here; he has risen, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay. 7 Then go quickly and tell his disciples: 'He has risen from the dead and is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him.' Now I have told you." Matthew 28:5-7 (NIV)

Open up the orange egg and watch the bubbles rise. Jesus wished his friends good bye and rose up through the skies.



Draw Jesus going behind the clouds.

After he said this, He was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid him from their sight. Acts 1:9 (NIV)
