- * 1:2-3 ministry during: King Josiah
King Amon
King Zedekiah
exile of Jerusalem
- * 1:4 - the Lord spoke to Jeremiah
- * 1:5 - God knew Jeremiah before He was born and appointed him as a prophet
- * 1:6 - Jeremiah tells God that he is young and can't speak to others
- * 1:7-8 - God tells Jeremiah that it doesn't matter that he's young, God will be with him
- * 1:9-10 - God touched Jeremiah's mouth and gave him the words to speak
- * 1:11-13 - God asks Jeremiah what he sees and Jeremiah answers Him
- * 1:14-16 - God explains what the pot means - it means that Israel will be destroyed by people in the North because of their wickedness
- * 1:17 - God tells Jeremiah to get ready and go speak to the people
- * 1:18 - God tells Jeremiah that He has made him strong
- * 1:19 - Jeremiah is told that the people are going to fight against him, but not to worry because God will be with him
