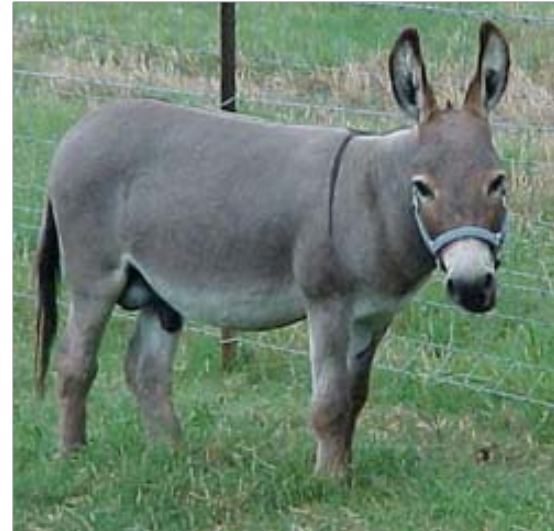
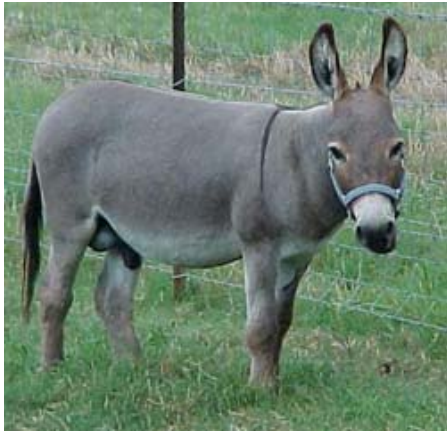


Palm Sunday

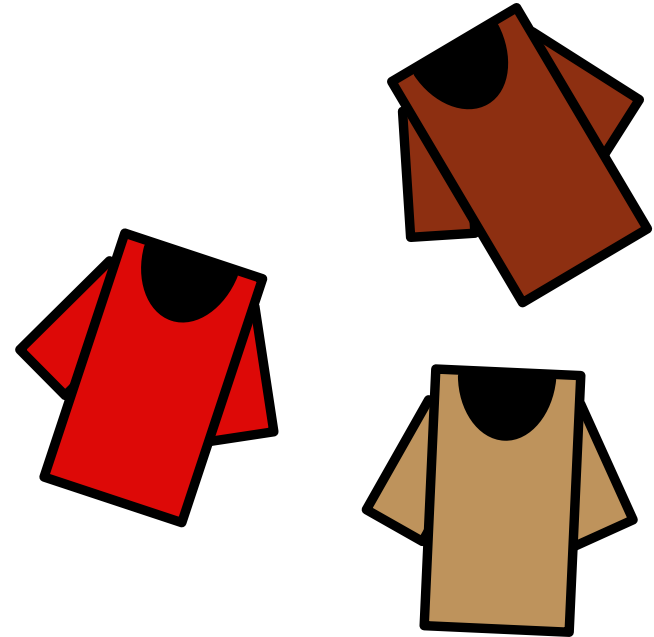


This took place so that what was spoken through the prophet would come true. It says,
