



The Triumphal Entry

Matthew 21:1-11 Reader

When they had **1**
ap-proached
Je-ru-sa-lem and
had come to Beth-
phage, at the Mount
of O-lives, then Je-
sus sent two
di-sci-ples, say-ing to
them,

2 "Go into the vil-lage
op-po-site you, and
im-me-di-ate-ly you
will find a don-key
tied *there* and a colt
with her; un-tie them
and bring them to Me.

3 If an-y-one says
an-y-thing to you,
you shall say, 'The
Lord has need of
them,' and
im-me-di-ate-ly he
will send them."

4 This took place to
ful-fill what was
spok-en through the
pro-phet:
"Say to the daugh-ter
of Zi-on,
'Be-hold your King is
com-ing to you,
Gen-tle, and mount-ed
on a don-key,
E-ven on a colt, the
foal of a beast of
bur-den."

The di-sci-ples went⁵
and did just as
Je-sus had
in-struct-ed them,
and brought the
don-key and the colt,
and laid their coats
on them; and He sat
on the coats.

6 Most of the crowd
spread their coats in
the road, and oth-ers
were cut-ting
branch-es from the
trees and spread-ing
them in the road.

The crowds go-ing 7
a-head of Him, and
those who fol-lowed,
were shout-ing,
"Ho-san-na to the
Son of Da-vid;
Bles-sed is He who
comes in the name
of the Lord;
Ho-san-na in the
high-est!"

8 When He had en-tered
Je-ru-sa-lem, all the
ci-ty was stirred,
say-ing, "Who is this?"
And the crowds were
say-ing, "This is the
pro-phet Je-sus,
from Na-za-reth in
Ga-li-lee."
