Matthew 26:20-35 Reader

Now when e-ven-ing <sup>1</sup>  
came, Je-sus was  
re-clin-ing *at the*  
*ta-ble* with the  
twelve di-sci-ples. As  
they were eat-ing, He  
said, "Tru-ly I say to  
you that one of you  
will be-tray Me."

2 Be-ing deep-ly  
grieved, they each  
one be-gan to say to  
Him, "Sure-ly not I,  
Lord?" And He an-  
swered, "He who  
dipped his hand with  
Me in the bowl is the  
one who will be-tray  
Me.

The Son of Man *is to* 3  
go, just as it is  
writ-ten of Him; but  
woe to that man by  
whom the Son of  
Man is be-trayed! It  
would have been good  
for that man if he  
had not been born."

4 And Ju-das, who was  
be-tray-ing Him, said,

"Sure-ly it is not I,

Rab-bi?" Je-sus said

to him, "You have said

*it your-self."*

5 While they were  
eat-ing, Je-sus took  
*some* bread, and  
af-ter a bles-sing, He  
broke *it* and gave *it*  
to the dis-ci-ples, and  
said, "Take, eat; this is

*My bod-y."*

6 And when He had tak-en a cup and giv-en thanks, He gave *it* to them, say-ing, "Drink from it, all of you; for this is My blood of the cov-e-nant, which is poured out for man-y for for-give-ness of sins.

But I say to you, I 7 will not drink of this fruit of the vine from now on un-til that day when I drink it new with you in My Fath-er's king-dom."
