
Craft one: "Sharing and Caring Envelopes" (Homemade stationary)

You will need:

- Paper or notecards
- Scissors
- Stickers or small treats
- Markers or decorating materials
- Envelopes (any size)

Procedure:

- Decorate the envelopes, adding stickers and notes as desired.
- 2. Write verses or special messages on paper or note cards.
- 3. Add treats or stickers into the envelope.









Craft Two: "Share a Game"


You will need:

- Paper or cardstock
- Pipe cleaners
- Decorative materials (markers, fabric paint)

Procedure:

- 1. Decorate your "game board", tracing lines to make a tic-tac-toe game board (nine squares total)
- 2. Add verse caption and title, if desired.
- 3. Bend the pipe cleaners into alternating shapes such as "X's" or "O's"
- 4. Add additional decorations as desired.
- 5. Take turns laying down your pipe cleaner pieces and sharing the game with friends!
