# Simple Bedtime Prayers for Children

Teaching children to pray often includes learning a few sample prayers by memory. Use these evening prayers for kids every night at bedtime.

You should teach kids to pray using their own words, but these route prayers are powerful tools to help children build confidence in their talking with God.

When possible, I prefer biblical prayers. For longer prayers, practice them at bedtime for one week, then move to the next. After a few weeks, start from the beginning of the list or incorporate new prayers into the list.

## Bedtime Prayer: Our Father Prayer (the Lord's Prayer) Matthew 6

---

Pray then like this:

"Our Father in heaven,  
hallowed be your name.  
Your kingdom come,  
your will be done,  
on earth as it is in heaven.  
Give us this day our daily bread,  
and forgive us our debts,  
as we also have forgiven our debtors.  
And lead us not into temptation,  
but deliver us from evil.

Matthew 6:9-13 ESV
