



Level Up: 4-Week Preschool Curriculum

The *Level Up* Preschool Curriculum helps little ones (ages 3–5) discover that Jesus gives them a brand-new life and helps them grow strong in Him. Each week, preschoolers will hear simple Bible stories that show how Jesus loves them, helps them, and gives them everything they need to follow Him. Lessons are interactive and engaging, so children can joyfully learn that with Jesus, they can always “level up” in love and faith.

💡 **Big Idea:** Jesus makes me new and helps me grow!

📖 **Bible Memory Verse:** “When anyone lives in Christ, the new creation has come. The old is gone! The new is here! (2 Corinthians 5:17 NIV)

✝️ **Gospel Connection:** Across four Sundays, kids see our need for a Savior, Jesus’ rescue, and how His Spirit helps us grow—so we trust Christ, not self-effort.

4-Week PreK Lesson Overview

Week 1 – Jesus Gives Me a Fresh Start!

- Bible Story: New Creation in Christ (2 Corinthians 5:17)
- Summary: Jesus makes me brand new! When I follow Him, I get to start fresh. This week, we learn that no matter what, Jesus loves us and gives us a new beginning.

Week 2 – Jesus Knows My Name!

- Bible Story: God’s call of Jeremiah (Jeremiah 1:5)
- Summary: God made me special and knows my name! This week, we learn that Jesus made us on purpose and has a good plan for each of us.

Week 3 – Jesus Helps Me Talk to God!

- Bible Story: Pray about everything (Philippians 4:6–7)
- Summary: I can talk to God about anything! Jesus helps me pray and gives me peace. This week, we learn that prayer is like a special power that helps us every day.

Week 4 – Jesus Helps Me Say No to Wrong!

- Bible Story: Jesus in the wilderness (Matthew 4:1–11)
- Summary: Jesus beat temptation with God’s Word. This week, we learn that when we feel tempted, we can remember God’s words and ask Jesus for help—He always helps us do what’s right.
